Pursuant to Supreme Court Administrative Order 1989-2, and the approval of the State Court Administrator, IT IS ORDERED that the following procedures shall govern the use of the videotape record of court proceedings in the Third Judicial Circuit.

- The courtrooms of Judge Charles Kaufman and Judge William Leo Cahalan located at 1601 and 1111 City-County Building, respectively, are designated as the courtrooms which shall use the videotape record of court proceedings.
- Notice to the attorneys, litigants, and public of the videotape record being used in these courtrooms shall be made by providing copies of the attached notice at the courtroom, in the Court Administrator's Office, and the Clerk's Office, Room 201 of the City-County Building, and by publication in the Detroit Legal News.
- 3. The second copy of the videotape required by Supreme Court Administrative Order 1989-2, shall be stored off the court premises in the Court's Information Systems Bureau located at 1300 Cadillac Tower Building, 65 Cadillac Square, Detroit, MI.

This order hereby rescinds Administrative Order 1989-2, which provided for a single courtroom using the videotape record.
