


SUBJECT: DIVORCE ACTIONS WHERE QUESTIONS ARE RAISED AS TO THE
PATERNITY OF A CHILD FOR WHICH THE MOTHER IS RECEIVING ADC

EFFECTIVE: EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 2, 1990

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that when questions have been raised in a divorce action as to the paternity of a child for which the mother is receiving ADC, the Court shall conduct an evidentiary hearing to determine if the allegations rebutting the presumption of legitimacy can be proven by clear and convincing evidence. If the allegations rebutting the presumption are proven by clear and convincing evidence, the Judgement of Divorce shall specifically find that the husband is not the father of the minor child in question.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that when such a finding occurs the Court clerk shall forthwith provide the Friend of the Court with such information by completing the form entitled "Notification to the Friend of the Court-Finding of Non-Paternity" attaching same to a true copy of the Judgement of Divorce and submitting said documents to the Office of the Friend of the Court, 710 City-County Building.
