Pursuant to Supreme Court Administrative Order 1990-7, and the approval of the State Court Administrator, IT IS ORDERED that the following procedures shall govern the use of the videotape record of court proceedings in the Third Judicial Circuit.

- The courtrooms 907, 1111, 1401, 1507, 1601, 1701 and 1907 located at the City-County Building are designated as courtrooms which shall use the videotape record of court proceedings.
- 2. Notice to the attorneys, litigants, and public of the videotape record being used in these courtrooms shall be made by providing copies of the attached notice at the courtroom, in the Court Administrator's Office, and the Clerk's Office, Room 201 of the City-County Building, and by publication in the Detroit Legal News.
- 3. The second copy of the videotape required by Supreme Court Administrative Order 1990-7, shall be stored off the court premises in the Court's Information Systems Bureau located at 1300 Cadillac Tower Building, 65 Cadillac Square, Detroit, MI.

This order hereby rescinds Amended Administrative Order 1990-9, which provided for six courtrooms using the videotape record.
