SUBJECT: VIDEOTAPE RECORD OF COURT PROCEEDINGS

EFFECTIVE: JUNE 10, 1993

Pursuant to Supreme Court Administrative Order 1990-7, and the approval of the State Court Administrator, IT IS ORDERED that the following procedures shall govern the use of the videotape record of court proceedings in the Third Judicial Circuit.

- 1. The courtrooms 907, 1007, 1111, 1401, 1501, 1507, 1601, 1701, 1907 and 1913 located at the City-County Building are designated as courtrooms which shall use the videotape record of court proceedings.
- 2. Notice to the attorneys, litigants, and public of the videotape record being used in these courtrooms shall be made by providing copies of the attached notice at the courtroom, in the Court Administrator's Office, and the Clerk's Office, Room 201 of the City-County Building, and by publication in the Detroit Legal News.
- 3. The second copy of the videotape required by Supreme Court Administrative Order 1990-7, shall be stored off the court premises in the Court's Information Systems Bureau located at 1300 Cadillac Tower Building, 65 Cadillac Square, Detroit, MI.
- 4. The fee for duplicating a videotape shall be made payable to the "Third Judicial Circuit."

This order hereby rescinds Administrative Order 1993-1, which provided for nine courtrooms using the videotape record.
