STATE OF MICHIGAN THIRD JUDICIAL CIRCUIT

SUBJECT: WAIVER OF JURISDICTION OVER CIVIL INFRACTIONS

Pursuant to MCL 712A.2e, the Third Judicial Circuit Court and the 23rd District Court enter into the following AGREEMENT:

- 1. The Third Judicial Circuit Court waives jurisdiction over all civil infractions alleged to have been committed by juveniles within the geographic jurisdiction of the 23rd District Court.
- 2. Upon execution of this AGREEMENT, the 29th District Court has jurisdiction over the juvenile in the same manner as if an adult had committed the civil infraction.
- 3. The 23rd District Court would waive jurisdiction over a traffic civil infraction if there was a misdemeanor charge arising from the same incident. The misdemeanor and traffic civil infraction would be forwarded to the Third Circuit Court for disposition.

Copies of this ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER and AGREEMENT shall be provided to all affected law enforcement agencies. This ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER and AGREEMENT shall be effective July 1, 1999. Any modifications shall be provided to the State Court Administrative Office.
