STATE OF MICHIGAN THIRD JUDICIAL CIRCUIT

SUBJECT: VIDEOTAPE RECORD OF COURT PROCEEDINGS

IT IS ORDERED:

Pursuant to Supreme Court Administrative Order 1990-7, and the approval of the State Court Administrator, the following procedures shall govern the use of the videotape record of court proceedings in the Third Judicial Circuit:

- 1. The courtrooms 907, 1507, 1611, 1701, 1801 and 1813, located at the Coleman A. Young Municipal Center, and the courtrooms 1243 and 1248, located at the Juvenile Detention Facility, are designated as courtrooms which shall use the videotape record of court proceedings. Additional courtrooms will be added as necessary.
- 2. Notice to the attorneys, litigants, and public of the videotape record being used in courtrooms shall be made by providing copies of the attached Notice in the videotape courtrooms, in the Executive Court Administrator's Office, in the County Clerk's Offices, Room 201 of the Coleman A. Young Municipal Center, Room 330 of the Lincoln Hall of Justice, and by publication in the Detroit Legal News.
- 3. The second copy of the videotape required by Supreme Court Administrative Order 1990-7 shall be stored off the court premises in the Court's designated storage facility.

This Order hereby rescinds Administrative Order 1993-3, which provided for courtrooms using the videotape record.
