LOCAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2013 - 101

Third Judicial Circuit State of Michigan

SUBJECT: SENTENCING TIME STANDARDS FOR DEFENDANTS IN THE WAYNE COUNTY JAIL

This Local Administrative Order is issued under authority of MCR 8.112(B) and establishes a standard interval for the period of time between plea or conviction and sentencing [(MCR 6.425(E)].

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. The Court must sentence a defendant incarcerated in the Wayne County Jail within (21) days after the plea or verdict, unless the Court delays sentencing based on a finding of extraordinary circumstances made on the record or otherwise as provided by law.
- 2. The consent of the parties, standing alone, does not constitute extraordinary circumstances.
- 3. The Court shall not consider the likelihood of early release of a defendant sentenced to the Wayne County Jail in determining whether extraordinary circumstances exist.
